

Everglades Int'l Hostel Race Fan Reservation Agreement

I, _____ realize and accept on behalf of myself and my party, that Everglades International Hostel (EIH) is **NOT A HOTEL** but instead (as the name implies) an International Hostel, that is making an EXCEPTION for Race Fan Enthusiasts, like myself, who failed to make a reservation at our more familiar accommodation establishments (and now have a loved one throwing things and informing me that I can never do anything right... anyway...) I am very thankful that EIH is making an exception for myself and my fellow enthusiasts by renting out entire dormitory rooms and private room combinations. I understand that EIH is a unique environment that I will love and remember forever!!! And if I choose to, that I can get to hang out with people from all over the world who have no idea what Nascar racing is! And in keeping with the hostelling spirit I will share all I know about Nascar racing with any and all willing ears!! I understand that: the Sleeping House is 1930's Art Deco boarding house; And there is a spacious tropical garden filled with whimsical cool things like a garden bed and candle-lit chess-set, a gazebo and fishpond; A Kitchen House that is stocked with dishes, pots, pans, oils, spices and fresh herbs, that I can use to cook wonderful meals and share with anyone who appreciates a fine culinary experience (like Owynn ☺); That there is internet access, and a really awesome movie room and a BBQ area where I can cook hot dogs (cause I know Owynn doesn't like hot dogs, unless she's really hungry, and I really don't want to share my dinner with her at all!)

I promise NOT to take part in any sort of activities that might involve police officers having to come to EIH and I would like to further promise NOT to be up all hours of the night hoot'n and holler'n and carrying-on, (like that guy few years back, when everybody and their dog was telling him to shut-up this, and shut-up that, and then in the morning he had no idea why everybody was looking at him like he was an**%#@&! or something and his friends were acting like they had no clue who he was... so anyhow I promise not to do... that...)

I also understand that ONLY REGISTERED HOSTEL GUESTS are allowed on the hostel property so I will not grab 20 of my very closest buddies I just met at the track and tell them that there's a "kegger" at "MY PLACE"!

I understand that a hostel kind of feels like summer camp for adults: you stay in dormitory-style rooms with people who are pretty much your peers. You socialize, talk about the places you've traveled to, the places you are going to, share information, cook meals, clean-up after yourself, including bathrooms, or you can be anti-social if you want, but you will still need to clean-up after yourself. I understand that the Hostel's primary purpose is to provide people, young at heart, with a clean, safe and affordable place to stay while traveling the world. The Hostel provides a place to cook meals and do laundry as well as a place to get local information on the area's culture, history, and activities. (But the coolest part of all is NO Camp Counselors! and no lousy camp food! and you can sneak out whenever you want! and eat candy and ice cream all day long!!)

I understand that if I wanted to I could have stayed in a dorm with other world-traveling hostellers for a mere \$13 to \$17 per night plus tax but I really can't make that leap just yet, so I'll rent the entire room or suite all to myself.

I understand that most rooms are set-up in dormitory style with custom-made wooden bunk beds for adults although there are a couple rooms with a double bed each. I understand Bathrooms are shared unless you specifically reserve a room with a bathroom ensuite. Some rooms have window a/c units and others have fans. THERE ARE NO TV'S OR PHONE'S IN THE ROOMS but Please do note we have an excellent large screen movie room a surround sound system, cable, movie library, and a guest phone in the kitchen house.

I understand that, although this agreement may be funny, IT IS NOT TO BE CONSIDERED A JOKE, and that the staff at EIH loves to take any opportunity available to expose people to hostelling who might never have stayed in one and really want me to know the rules so there are no misunderstandings, and also want me to know that this place is unique and well ... what-the-heck, it's either here or sleep with gators!

I understand that this reservation will be confirmed only after the hostel has received my credit details on an Advance Resort Deposit Form and even then only after I receive a fax copy of my credit card charge for 100% of the total bill. This charge will be billed immediately to my Visa or MasterCard. **A 2-night minimum for race fans renting full dorms and private room combinations is required.** I understand I have 24 hours from when I sign and fax my Advance Resort Deposit to cancel my reservation with a refund after this initial **24-hour Cancellation Period** my advance resort deposit, in its entirety, becomes **non-refundable**.
